Report for the 2010 (March 2011) Town Report accepted by unanimous vote and signed by all five members of the NHCC. Louis will present it to Pete Johnson, Town Clerk/Treasurer on Monday.

Budget for fiscal year 2011 was accepted at:

Repairs/seeding	\$2,000
Restoration	\$3,000
<u>Improvements</u>	<u>\$3,000</u>
Total:	\$8,000

This represents level funding from last year. Budget approved by unanimous vote and will be presented to Pete Johnson, Town Clerk/Treasurer on Monday.

We discussed the mapping contract and it was unanimously agreed that we would try once more for some resolution to this on-going situation and if no further action is forthcoming we will discuss with the Selectboard about use of town lawyer.

Trees have been removed from the north side of the South End Cemetery (on the far side of the fence.) Public Works did the initial clearing and Matt Spear was hired to take down the trees. This work will enable Public Works to mow entirely around the cemetery and therefore will prevent the growth of trees that hang over the fence and endanger gravestones/monuments. All adjacent property owners were met with and their permission was given to proceed with this project.

Public Works also cleared some fallen limbs that damaged a gravestone at Hyde Cemetery. There is still one dead tree that needs to be removed. Public Works will see to this.

Kevin Daignault is working with Andre Quintin about work to be done around the outside of the fence at Jerusalem Cemetery and with Mike Scandore about like work to be done at North End Cemetery.
