NORTH HERO SELECTBOARD

The North Hero Selectboard passed a revised dog ordinance at its March 1, 2010 meeting. In summary, the purpose of this ordinance is to regulate the keeping of dogs, to protect public health and safety, and to protect residents' quiet enjoyment of their homes and properties. Provisions under this ordinance include the following: Definitions, Disturbances and Nuisances, Pooper Scooper, Collar and License, Humane Care of Dogs, Enforcement, Animal Control Officer Duties, Impoundment, Notice of Impoundment and Release from Impoundment, Boarding and Veterinary Fees, Appeals, and Severability. A copy of the full text of the Dog Ordinance may be found in the Town Office at 6441 U.S. Route 2 in North Hero. Questions about the ordinance may be addressed to Marie Kilbride, Selectboard Chair, at 372-3317. This ordinance will take effect on April 30, 2010, unless a petition signed by at least five percent of the voters of North Hero is filed with the Town Clerk by April 14, 2010, asking for a vote to disapprove the ordinance. If a petition is received, the North Hero Selectboard will warn a special meeting and the voters may vote on that question.
