

MINUTES OF THE NORTH HERO RECREATION COMMITTEE

June 1, 2010, Town Offices Camp Ingalls

1. The Board voted to approve and pay the following bills: no bills were pending. A brief discussion of budget and accounting policy was discussed. We need to evaluate how to project our expenditures. A discussion with the new budget should be undertaken at the end of the summer.
2. Mowing at Pelots was discussed. The pathways need to be mowed now, although we are short of budget. Chip agreed to do the Number one trail near the parking lot. Kevin could be asked to mow the trails. Ethan will contact him.
3. Stephen and Chip will try to finish the trash at the old dump site at Pelots.
4. Summer camps were discussed. At this time Mary Jo's summer camp for children is proceeding. The two sports camps are scheduled for late July and early August, and there is some possibility of an Art Camp organized by Danielle. A dance class associated with Island Arts was discussed briefly. Stephen reminded us of how important it is to advertise our scholarships to local students. He is familiar with a group working with children in the area and reported that many of the children had no plans for the summer. One issue we might try to address is transportation in addition to scholarship monies.
5. There may be a 5 K Fun Run scheduled for the end of July. It could originate at Ingalls and proceed up the West Shore Road. Having it on a Saturday would conflict with the Transfer Station traffic.
